**Information Asset Classification System (IACS)  
General Information**

<b>What is IACS?</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- A free on-line tool to assist NYS agencies in performing information asset classification</li> <li>- Allows agencies to classify their information assets in accordance with the <i>NYS Information Classification Standard (NYS-S14-002)</i></li> <li>- Once information is classified, the tool provides a concise list of baseline controls that must be applied in accordance with the <i>NYS Information Security Controls Standard (NYS-S14-003)</i></li> <li>- Satisfies the <i>NYS Information Security Policy</i> requirement to maintain an inventory of information assets and their classifications</li> </ul>
<b>Key Features</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Responsive HTML5 user interface</li> <li>- Flexibility to add custom controls, questions, roles and storage names</li> <li>- Search by asset information, classification or classification date</li> <li>- Filtering options to generate detailed reports</li> <li>- Ability to export classification data to Excel</li> <li>- Changes to information assets are tracked</li> <li>- Asset templates and classifications provided for the <a href="#">General Retention and Disposition Schedule for NYS Government Records</a></li> <li>- Ability to perform security controls gap analysis for each classified asset</li> </ul>
<b>Agency Entitlement Responsibilities</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Agency NYSDS Entitlement Administrators grant and manage access, including the removal of access when no longer needed</li> <li>- Agency notifies the Enterprise Information Security Office of any change in status of their designated NYSDS Entitlement Administrators or their designated <i>Agency Administrator</i> for IACS</li> </ul>
<b>Technical Information</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Application access via NY.gov Online Services</li> <li>- Each agency has an separate database in the application (i.e., no co-mingling of data)</li> <li>- Application fields <i>Name of Information Asset, Information Asset Description/Comment, Information Asset Use</i> and <i>Information Asset ID Number</i> are stored encrypted with AES</li> <li>- Agency databases are backed up nightly (30 days of data are kept)</li> <li>- Compatible with IE8 (or later), Firefox, Chrome and Safari</li> <li>- Developed in ColdFusion with a SQL database</li> </ul>
