I am pleased to announce the appointment of Kim McKinney as Chief Operating Officer (COO) for the New York State Office of Information Technology Services (ITS). In this role, Kim will be responsible for managing the delivery of enterprise IT services under a shared services model. The COO is a new senior leadership position created under the auspice of the IT Transformation initiative to enhance the State's IT capabilities in delivering vital government services in a cost effective manner.

Kim has more than 30 years' experience delivering mission critical IT services in local government, private sector, and higher education. Most recently, she served as Commissioner of Information Technology for Orange County and prior to that she was Chief Information Officer for Broome County for more than fifteen years. Her experience and responsibilities have included managing operations for the County's Computer Center, Telecommunications, GIS and Records Management. In these roles she managed county IT staff and vendor contracts to deliver IT services to 40 County departments and local police agencies. She also provided strategic leadership and vision for the County in all areas involving technology.

In addition, Kim is an active participant and contributor to the state's IT community. She served as President of the New York State Local Government Information Technology Director's Association for four years representing 70 local governments. She was a member of the New York State CIO Council, a member of the CIO Council Leadership team, and Co-Chaired the Open Government Communication & Collaboration Committee. She has also served on the Executive Board of New York State Forum.
