If yes, will NYS ITS maintain access to all the third party tools listed?	Yes, integrations to third parties are anticipated to be required. At minimum, these may include those used by county probation departments, Alternative to Incarceration Programs, and NYS Department of Corrections and Community Supervision (DOCCS). NYS ITS may not have direct access to all of these tools, but may have a role in facilitating connections to the respective vendors in regard to any integrations.
